A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR STAFFING AND SUPPORT TO OPEN
FIVE NEWLY CONSTRUCTED STATE RECREATION AREAS AT FALLS
AND JORDAN LAKES.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Natural Resources and Community Development, Division of Parks and Recreation, the sum of seven hundred twenty-nine thousand nine hundred nine dollars (\$729,909) for the 1989-90 fiscal year and the sum of four hundred ninety thousand nine hundred nine dollars (\$490,909) for the 1990-91 fiscal year to provide 21 staff and support to open Popular Point, Seaforth, Crosswinds, and Ebenezer Recreation Areas at Jordan Lake, and Rollingview Recreation Area at Falls Lake, all constructed and completed by the Corps of Engineers in compliance with existing legislation.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
