G.S. 14-1 reads as rewritten: 5 6 "§ 14-4. Violation of local ordinances misdemeanor. 7 Except as provided in subsection (b), if any person shall violate an ordinance of a county, city, or town, he shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined not 8 more than fifty dollars (\$50.00) two hundred dollars (\$200.00), or imprisoned for not 9

more than fifty dollars (\$50.00)two hundred dollars (\$200.00), or imprisoned for not more than 30 days.

(b) If any person shall violate an ordinance of a county, city, or town regulating the operation or parking of vehicles he shall be responsible for an infraction and shall

- the operation or parking of vehicles, he shall be responsible for an infraction and shall be required to pay a penalty of not more than fifty dollars (\$50.00) two hundred dollars (\$200.00)."
- Sec. 2. This act shall become effective with respect to violations committed on or after October 1, 1989.
