A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO RAISE THE FINE OR MONETARY PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF  
A CITY ORDINANCE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 14-1 reads as rewritten:

**"§ 14-4. Violation of local ordinances misdemeanor.**

(a) Except as provided in subsection (b), if any person shall violate an ordinance of a county, city, or town, he shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined not more than ~~fifty dollars (\$50.00)~~ two hundred dollars (\$200.00), or imprisoned for not more than 30 days.

(b) If any person shall violate an ordinance of a county, city, or town regulating the operation or parking of vehicles, he shall be responsible for an infraction and shall be required to pay a penalty of not more than ~~fifty dollars (\$50.00)~~ two hundred dollars (\$200.00)."

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective with respect to violations committed on or after October 1, 1989.
