A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE COMMUNITY BASED
ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Human Resources, Division of Youth Services, the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for the 1989-90 fiscal year and the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for the 1990-91 fiscal year for the Community Based Alternatives Program. Of these funds, five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) each fiscal year shall be allocated among the counties on a per capita basis, and five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) each fiscal year shall be allocated evenly among all 100 counties.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
