SENATE BILL 420

Short Title: Youth Advocacy/Involvement Funds.

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR POSITIONS AND ASSISTANCE FOR
THE OFFICE OF YOUTH ADVOCACY AND INVOLVEMENT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Administration, Office of Youth Advocacy and Involvement, the sum of seventy-eight thousand dollars (\$78,000) for the 1989-90 fiscal year and the sum of seventy-eight thousand dollars (\$78,000) for the 1990-91 fiscal year to fund two Child Advocacy Specialist positions to be based in the eastern and western parts of North Carolina.

Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Administration, Office of Youth Advocacy and Involvement, the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) for the 1989-90 fiscal year to assist in conducting a statewide conference on child advocacy and children's legislation.

Sec. 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Administration, Office of Youth Advocacy and Involvement, the sum of thirty thousand five hundred dollars (\$30,500) for the 1989-90 fiscal year and the sum of thirty thousand five hundred dollars (\$30,500) for the 1990-91 fiscal year to fund a State Youth Council Program Coordinator position.

Sec. 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
