SENATE BILL 494

Short Title: Winery Special Show Permits.

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR WINERY SPECIAL SHOW PERMITS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 18B-1001 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:

"(12) Winery Special Show Permit. – A winery special show permit may be issued to the holder of a winery permit, and authorizes the permittee to give free tastings and to sell fortified and unfortified wine at trade shows, conventions, wine festivals, or similar events. The permit may be issued for:

a. Restaurants;

b. Hotels; or

c. Convention Centers."

Sec. 2. G.S. 18B-902 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:

"(28) Winery Special Show Permit – \$25.00."

Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
