**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED**

**AN ACT TO DIRECT THE STATE TO TRANSFER A TRACT OF STATE LAND  
TO THE TOWN OF CAROLINA BEACH FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF A  
YOUTH CENTER.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any provision of Article 2C of Chapter 113 of the General Statutes or any other provision of State or federal law, the State shall transfer approximately 22.8 acres of land within the Carolina Beach State Park, located to the East of SR 1534 (Dow Road) and directly opposite the entrance to the Carolina Beach State Park, to the Town of Carolina Beach for the development of a youth center on the land. The deeds shall be executed in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 146 of the General Statutes.

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
