A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF
ADMINISTRATION TO HELP SUPPORT DOMESTIC VIOLENCE
PREVENTION PROGRAMS AND CENTERS.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Administration, Council on the Status of Women the sum of nine hundred sixty-seven thousand one hundred eighty-six dollars (\$967,186) for the 1989-90 fiscal year and the sum of nine hundred sixty-seven thousand one hundred eighty-six dollars (\$967,186) for the 1990-91 fiscal year for the prevention of domestic violence to be allocated as follows:

- (1) Twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) in fiscal year 1989-90 and twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) in fiscal year 1990-91 shall be used for a grant-in-aid to the North Carolina Coalition Against Domestic Violence, Incorporated.
- (2) Each of the 61 domestic violence centers in operation on February 1, 1989, that offered services including a hotline, transportation services, community education programs, daytime services, and call forwarding during the night shall receive a grant of thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) each year of the biennium to be used for the operation of the center.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
