A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE ANTIQUE VILLAGE OF WILSON COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Cultural Resources for the Antique Village of Wilson County, Inc., the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 1989-90 fiscal year to renovate the former Lamm's Elementary School building and transform it into the Antique Exhibition Center of the South, a tourism project that would benefit the economy of Wilson County and the State of North Carolina, provided local funds are raised by the Antique Village of Wilson County, Inc., to match the State funds on a dollar-for-dollar basis.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 1989.
