2 AN ACT TO REQUIRE BONDS OF DISTRIBUTORS AND SUBDISTRIBUTORS OF MILK.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 106-266.10 reads as rewritten:

# "§ 106-266.10. Licenses: Licenses; bonds for distributors and subdistributors.

- (a) An application to the Commission for a license to operate as a distributor or subdistributor shall be made by mail or otherwise within 30 days after the provisions of this Article become effective in a market, and as to any distributor or subdistributor thereafter beginning business, before such distributor or subdistributor shall begin such business therein. The application shall be made on blanks furnished by the Commission for that purpose. Each distributor shall cooperate with the Commission in seeing to it that its subdistributors are informed concerning, and comply with, the provisions of this Article and the rules and regulations duly adopted by the Commission.
- (b) All applications shall be accompanied by a bond sufficient in amount to cover all amounts due the producers of milk or cooperative associations for two normal or customary pay periods, but not to exceed 25 days in total, based upon the average of the preceding six month period of purchases from milk producers or cooperative associations; provided that the minimum bond shall not be less than the amount sufficient to cover amounts due producers or cooperative associations for one week's purchases. This bond shall be signed by the distributor or subdistributor dealer and by a company authorized to execute surety bonds in North Carolina and shall be made payable to the State of North Carolina. The bond shall be conditioned on the distributor's or subdistributor's faithful performance of his duties as a distributor or

- subdistributor and his compliance with this Article, and shall be for the use and benefit of any person from whom the distributor or subdistributor purchased milk and who has not been paid by the distributor or subdistributor. The bond shall be given for the period for which the distributor's or subdistributor's license is issued.
- (c) Any person claiming to be injured by nonpayment, fraud, deceit, negligence, or other misconduct of a distributor or subdistributor may institute a suit or suits against this distributor or subdistributor and his sureties upon the bond in the name of the State, without any assignment thereof."
- 9 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 1991, and applies to license applications made on and after that date.
