A JOINT RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH
COMMISSION TO STUDY THE POSSIBILITY OF CREATING A SEPARATE
DEFINITION FOR PROFESSIONAL FIRE FIGHTERS WITHIN THE LOCAL
GOVERNMENTAL EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

5 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring:

6 Section 1. The Legislative Research Commission may study the benefits of 7 firemen who are full-time employees of a county or municipality, and consider the need 8 to create a separate class of employees within the Local Governmental Employee's 9 Retirement System defined as "professional fire fighters." The study shall include a

10 review of benefits, including retirement, death, and disability.

- 11 Sec. 2. The Legislative Research Commission may make an interim report, 12 including any recommendations, to the 1991 General Assembly, Regular Session 1992, 13 and a final report to the 1993 General Assembly.
- 14 Sec. 3. This resolution is effective upon ratification.
