## **HOUSE BILL 1216**

Short Title: N.C. Foreign Language Center. (Public) Sponsors: Representatives Hurley; Beard, Jeralds, McAllister, and Warner. Referred to: Appropriations. May 10, 1991 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE NORTH CAROLINA FOREIGN LANGUAGE CENTER. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. Chapter 125 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new Article to read: "ARTICLE 4. "NORTH CAROLINA FOREIGN LANGUAGE CENTER. "§ 125-20. North Carolina Foreign Language Center – establishment; location; administration. There is established a North Carolina Foreign Language Center within the Department of Cultural Resources, the Division of State Library. The North Carolina Foreign Language Center shall be located in the Headquarters Library of the Cumberland County Public Library and Information Center in Fayetteville. The management and operation of the North Carolina Foreign Language Center shall be the responsibility of the Cumberland County Public Library and Information Center under the supervision of the Division of State Library. "§ 125-21. North Carolina Foreign Language Center – purpose and duties. The purpose of the North Carolina Foreign Language Center shall be to: (a) Acquire and provide informational and recreational library materials (1) for the residents of the State who desire materials in foreign languages. Acquire and provide materials for learning English as a second (2)
