4	THE NORTH CAROLINA 4-H PROGRAM.
5	Whereas, the North Carolina 4-H and Youth Development Program currently
6	involves more than 200,000 participants, with the support of 25,000 volunteers; and
7	Whereas, the participation of the 4-H and Youth Development Program is
8	representative of the State population; and
9	Whereas, the program is focused on relevant issues and needs such as water
10	quality, waste management, career development, energy conservation, and youth at risk;
11	and
12	Whereas, the current expenditure for curriculum is less than twenty-five cents
13	$(25\phi)$ per child; Now, therefore,
14	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
15	Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of
16	Governors of The University of North Carolina, the sum of \$100,000 for the 1991-92
17	fiscal year and the sum of \$100,000 for the 1992-93 fiscal year for the North Carolina 4-
18	H Development Fund at North Carolina State University for curriculum support for the
19	North Carolina 4-H Program.
20	Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1991.
