1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE DISPOSAL OF CERTAIN CLASSES OF SOLID
3 WASTE BY INCINERATION.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. The title of G.S. 130A-309.10 reads as rewritten:

6 "**§ 130A-309.10. Prohibited acts relating to packaging; coded labeling of plastic**
7 **containers required; disposal of certain special wastes in landfills or by**
8 **incineration prohibited.**"

9 Sec. 2. G.S. 130A-309.10 is amended by adding a new subsection following
10 subsection (f) to read:

11 "(f1) In accordance with the following schedule, no person shall knowingly
12 dispose of the following special wastes by incineration:

13 (1) Lead-acid batteries, after October 1, 1991; provided, however,
14 subsection (f) of this section applies to the disposal of lead-acid
15 batteries by incineration when the facility is a waste-to-energy facility.

16 (2) Used oil, after October 1, 1991.

17 (3) Yard trash, after October 1, 1991.

18 (4) White goods, after October 1, 1991."

19 Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
