Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 1992-93 fiscal year for the North Carolina 4-H Development Fund at North Carolina State University for curriculum support for the North Carolina 4-H Program.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1992.
