A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE ANNUAL MEETING OF THE
ATLANTIC STATES MARINE FISHERIES COMMISSION.

Whereas, all of the Atlantic coast states are members of the Atlantic States
Marine Fisheries Commission; and

Whereas, each year, a different state hosts the annual meeting of the Atlantic
States Marine Fisheries Commission; and

Whereas, the purpose of the annual meeting is to promote discussion of
cooperative management of interjurisdictional fisheries in order to improve the long-
term benefits derived from these fisheries; and

Whereas, in 1992, the State of North Carolina will host the annual meeting of
the Atlantic States Marine Fisheries Commission; and

Whereas, the meeting will be held at Atlantic Beach, and will bring together
approximately 150 people, including legislators from the Atlantic coast states, senior
state and federal fishery managers, and representatives of the commercial and
recreational fishing industry; and

Whereas, sufficient funds are needed to cover the cost of the meeting; Now,
therefore,

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of
Environment, Health, and Natural Resources, Division of Marine Fisheries, the sum of
four thousand dollars (\$4,000) for the 1992-93 fiscal year to cover the cost of hosting
the annual meeting of the Atlantic States Marine Fisheries Commission.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1992.
