A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE CONTINUATION OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA'S MATHEMATICS AND SCIENCE EDUCATION NETWORK COLLEGE PROGRAM FOR MINORITY AND FEMALE STUDENTS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of two hundred eighty thousand dollars (\$280,000) for the 1992-93 fiscal year for the Mathematics and Science Network College Program established by Section 97.1 of Chapter 1014 of the 1985 Session Laws to increase the number of underrepresented students, minority and female, who graduate from high school with interests to pursue mathematics-related or science-related degrees at the university level. These funds shall be allocated as follows:

- (1) \$130,000 for Fayetteville State University; and
- 15 (2) \$150,000 for the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill,

whose Mathematics and Science Network programs will otherwise terminate for lack of funds.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1992.
