A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE CONTINUATION OF THE  
2 UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA'S MATHEMATICS AND SCIENCE  
3 EDUCATION NETWORK COLLEGE PROGRAM FOR MINORITY AND  
4 FEMALE STUDENTS.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of  
8 Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of two hundred eighty thousand  
9 dollars (\$280,000) for the 1992-93 fiscal year for the Mathematics and Science Network  
10 College Program established by Section 97.1 of Chapter 1014 of the 1985 Session Laws  
11 to increase the number of underrepresented students, minority and female, who graduate  
12 from high school with interests to pursue mathematics-related or science-related degrees  
13 at the university level. These funds shall be allocated as follows:

14 (1) \$130,000 for Fayetteville State University; and

15 (2) \$150,000 for the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill,

16 whose Mathematics and Science Network programs will otherwise terminate for lack of  
17 funds.

18 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1992.
