## A HOUSE RESOLUTION HONORING THE ROBERT GLENN HIGH SCHOOL

 BASEBALL TEAM IN FORSYTH COUNTY ON WINNING THE 1992 NORTH CAROLINA STATE 4-A BASEBALL CHAMPIONSHIP.Whereas, 1992 marks the third consecutive year that the Robert Glenn High School baseball team has played in the State 4-A Baseball Championship playoffs; and

Whereas, the Robert Glenn High School Bobcats entered the 1992 State 4-A Baseball Championship playoffs as number five in the nation by USA Today; and

Whereas, the Robert Glenn High School Bobcats won a two-game sweep of the best-of-three title series over Sanderson High School, beating the Spartans by a margin of 13-2 in the final championship game and becoming the State 4-A baseball champions; and

Whereas, the Robert Glenn High School Bobcats ended their 1992 baseball season with a successful record of 28-2; and

Whereas, the Robert Glenn High School baseball team deserves to be recognized and commended for its effort, determination, and success;
Now, therefore, be it resolved by the House of Representatives:
Section 1. The North Carolina House of Representatives extends its congratulations to the Robert Glenn High School Bobcats on winning the 1992 North Carolina State 4-A Baseball Championship.
