## March 18, 1991

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT TO PROVIDE EQUALIZATION FUNDS FOR THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS. 2 Whereas, the General Assembly is bound by the Constitution to provide by 3 taxation and otherwise for a general and uniform system of free public schools wherein 4 equal opportunities shall be provided for all students, regardless of the residence of the 5 student; and 6 7 Whereas, providing a quality education to all children is essential for 8 economic growth in North Carolina; and 9

Whereas, the ability of communities to support local schools varies greatly throughout the State;

Whereas, under the North Carolina Constitution the people have a right to the privilege of education, and it is the duty of the State to guard and maintain that right; Now, therefore,
