"(j1) It is a misdemeanor punishable as provided in G.S. 20-176	for a person to
drive a vehicle on a highway at a speed that is more than 15 miles per	r hour more than
the speed limit established by law for the highway where the offense	e occurred. Any
person convicted under this section may be imprisoned for not more	than 60 days or
fined not more than two hundred dollars (\$200.00) or both."	
Sec. 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 1991, and	d applies to all
misdemeanor speeders arrested on or after that date.
