AN ACT TO EXEMPT CERTAIN TRUCKS REQUIRED TO BE INSPECTED

UNDER FEDERAL REGULATIONS FROM HAVING TO ALSO BE INSPECTED UNDER THE STATE INSPECTION PROGRAM.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 20-183.2(a) reads as rewritten:

"(a) Every motor vehicle, trailer, semitrailer, and pole trailer not including trailers of a gross weight of less than 4,000 pounds and house trailers, trailers and not including commercial motor vehicles as defined in Parts 383.3, 390.5, and 391.85 of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations, registered or required to be registered in North Carolina when operated on the streets and highways of this State must display a current approved inspection certificate at such place on the vehicle as may be designated by the Commissioner, indicating that it has been inspected in accordance with this Part. Such motor vehicle shall thereafter be inspected and display a current inspection certificate as is required by subsection (b) hereof."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
