A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ADD ADDITIONAL ANABOLIC STEROIDS TO THE LIST OF
CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES AND TO MAKE OTHER CHANGES TO
CONFORM STATE LAW WITH THE FEDERAL LAW REGARDING THE
CONTROL OF ANABOLIC STEROIDS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 90-91(k) reads as rewritten:

"(k) ~~Any anabolic steroids, unless dispensed with a prescription by a registered pharmacist.~~ Anabolic steroids. The term 'anabolic steroid' means any ~~material, compound, mixture, or preparation containing an anabolic steroid, drug or hormonal substance, chemically and pharmacologically related to testosterone (other than estrogens, progestins, and corticosteroids) that promotes muscle growth, including, but not limited to, the following:~~

1. Methandrostenolone,
2. Stanozolol,
3. Ethylestrenol,
4. Nandrolone phenpropionate,
5. Nandrolone deconoate,
6. Testosterone propionate, ~~and~~
7. ~~Chorionic gonadotropin.~~ gonadotropin.
8. Boldenone.
9. Chlorotestosterone (4-chlortestosterone).
10. Clostebol.
11. Dehydrochlormethyltestostorone.

- 23 Except such term does not include an anabolic steroid which is
- 24 expressly intended for administration through implants to cattle or
- 25 other nonhuman species and which has been approved by the Secretary
- 26 of Health and Human Services for such administration. If any person
- 27 prescribes, dispenses, or distributes such steroid for human use, such
- 28 person shall be considered to have prescribed, dispensed, or distributed
- 29 an anabolic steroid within the meaning of this paragraph."
- 30 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1991.
