2 AN ACT TO MODIFY THE DUTIES OF THE MUSEUM OF HISTORY REGARDING THE ACCESSION OF HISTORICAL OBJECTS LOCATED IN 3

4 THE EXECUTIVE MANSION AND OTHER STATE-OWNED BUILDINGS.

- 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
 - Section 1. G.S. 121-7(b) reads as rewritten:

Insofar as practicable, the North Carolina Museum of History shall accession 7 "(b) and maintain records showing provenance, value, location, and other pertinent 8 information on such furniture, furnishings, decorative items, and other objects as have 9 historical or cultural importance and which are owned by or to be acquired by the State 10 for use in the State Capitol. Capitol and the Executive Mansion, and, upon request of the 11 Department of Administration, any other state-owned building. When any such item or 12 object has been entered in the accession records of the Museum of History, the 13 custodian of such item or object shall, upon its removal from the premises upon which it 14 was located or when it is otherwise disposed of, submit to the Museum of History 15 sufficient details concerning its removal or disposition to permit an adequate entry in 16 the accession records to the end that its location or disposition, and authority for such 17 18 change, shall be showed therein." 19

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
