A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE NORTH CAROLINA 4-H

PROGRAM.

Whereas, the North Carolina 4-H Camps are owned by the State, or deeded to an entity of the State, North Carolina State University; and

Whereas, no appropriated funds presently are allocated for the maintenance of these facilities; and

Whereas, those facilities provide educational and recreational services to more than 10,000 North Carolina families each year representative of the State population; and

Whereas, these properties represent capital assets of more than \$7,000,000 contributed by citizen volunteers; Now, therefore,

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 1992-93 fiscal year for the North Carolina 4-H Development Fund at North Carolina State University for camp operation funds for the North Carolina 4-H Camp Program.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1992.
