A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO INCREASE THE FINE FOR A VIOLATION OF AN ORDINANCE OF
2 PENDER COUNTY AND TO MAKE A TECHNICAL CORRECTION TO THE
3 CHARTER OF THE CITY OF WILMINGTON.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. G.S. 14-4(a) reads as rewritten:

7 "(a) Except as provided in subsection (b), if any person shall violate an ordinance
8 of a county, city, or town, he shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined not
9 more than ~~fifty dollars (\$50.00)~~, two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00), or imprisoned for
10 not more than 30 days."

11 Sec. 2. Section 1 of Chapter 119 of the 1991 Session Laws is amended by
12 deleting "Sec. 23.10." and by substituting "Sec. 23.11.".

13 Sec. 3. Section 1 of this act applies to Pender County only.

14 Sec. 4. Sections 1 and 2 of this act become effective 60 days after ratification
15 and apply to offenses occurring on or after that date. Section 2 of this act becomes
16 effective upon ratification.
