The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:				
Section 1. Article 8 of Chapter 90 of the General Statutes is amended by				
adding a new section to read:				
"§ 90-143.2. Certification of diagnostic imaging technicians.				
The State Board of Chiropractic Examiners shall certify the competence of any				
person employed by a licensed chiropractor practicing in the State if the employee's				
duties include the production of diagnostic images, whether by X ray or other imaging technology. Applicants for certification must demonstrate proficiency in the following

The Board of Examiners may adopt rules pertaining to initial educational requirements,
