A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO CALL AN ADVISORY REFERENDUM IN NORTHAMPTON  
COUNTY ON THE ISSUE OF HOSTING A HAZARDOUS WASTE FACILITY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The Northampton County Board of Elections shall conduct on  
May 7, 1991, an advisory referendum of the qualified voters of Northampton County.

The question shall appear on the ballot as follows:

"[ ] FOR Northampton County being the host county for a hazardous waste  
facility.

[ ] AGAINST Northampton County being the host county for a hazardous  
waste facility."

Sec. 2. The referendum called by Section 1 of this act shall be conducted in  
accordance with Chapter 163 of the General Statutes.

Sec. 3. The Northampton County Board of Elections shall send a certified  
copy of the abstract of the election returns to each member of the General Assembly  
representing Northampton County, and to the Speaker of the House of Representatives  
and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate.

Sec. 4. This act is effective upon ratification.
