A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR VARIOUS EDUCATION PROGRAMS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Youth and Family Counselling Service the sum of \$80,000 for the 1991-92 fiscal year and the sum of \$80,000 for the 1992-93 fiscal year, to allow the Service to continue the Grimes Alternative School Model Program, a community-based alternatives program for undisciplined juveniles in the public schools in Davidson County.

- Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Bringing It All Back Home Study Center at Appalachian State University the sum of \$40,000 for the 1991-92 fiscal year, and the sum of \$40,000 for the 1992-93 fiscal year, to allow the Center to continue its home remedies community-based alternatives program for undisciplined juveniles and their families.
- Sec. 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the McDowell County Board of Education the sum of \$50,000 for the 1991-92 fiscal year and the sum of \$50,000 for the 1992-93 fiscal year to allow the Board to continue the McSmiles Program. The purpose of the program is to work with at-risk, preschool-aged children and their parents so as to prevent truancy, high dropout rates, and discipline problems and increase parental involvement.
 - Sec. 4. This act becomes effective July 1, 1991.
