1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE NORTH CAROLINA INDIAN CULTURAL CENTER FOR DESIGN, CONSTRUCTION, AND OPERATING EXPENSES OF THE CENTER.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to The North Carolina Indian Cultural Center, Inc., the sum of \$50,000 for the 1991-92 fiscal year to be used for operating expenses of the Center.

Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to The North Carolina Indian Cultural Center, Inc., the sum of \$1,150,000 for the 1991-92 fiscal year to be used to complete Phase I of the Center which includes completion of the North Carolina Indian Cultural Center, construction of a visitors center/museum, design and construction of an Indian village complex, nature trails, rivers walks, and foot bridges, provided these funds are matched on the basis of \$2.00 of non-State funds for every \$1.00 of State funds.
