BILL SUMMARY: The proposed act authorizes the town of Long Beach to apply the occupancy tax to campground and recreational vehicle parks. The town of Long Beach was authorized to levy an occupancy tax, not to exceed 3%, in 1983. The revenue is distributed monthly and can be used for tourism development.
