A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A SECOND JUVENILE CODE REVISION COMMITTEE TO STUDY THE PROVISIONS OF THE EXISTING JUVENILE CODE THAT RELATE TO DELINQUENCY AND RECOMMEND NECESSARY REVISIONS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 143B-480 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

"(a1) There is created the Second Juvenile Code Revision Committee as an adjunct committee of the Governor's Crime Commission."

Sec. 2. G.S. 143B-480(c) is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:

"(7) The Second Juvenile Code Revision Committee shall study the problems relating to the delinquency provisions of Articles 41, 42, 43, 45, 46, 47, 48, 49, 50, 51, 52, 53, and 54 of Chapter 7A of the General Statutes and recommend necessary revisions that will preserve the rights of juveniles and the best interests of the State. It shall make a full and complete report to the General Assembly by March 1, 1995. This adjunct committee shall terminate on February 28, 1995."

Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
