A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO PROVIDE BUSING FOR ALL CHILDREN IN KINDERGARTEN
2 THROUGH GRADE 5, REGARDLESS OF HOW CLOSE THEY LIVE TO
3 THEIR SCHOOLS.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. G.S. 115C-242(4) reads as rewritten:

7 "(4) A local board of education ~~which~~that elects to operate a school bus
8 transportation ~~system,~~system shall not be required to provide
9 transportation for any school employee, nor shall ~~such~~the board be
10 required to provide transportation for any pupil in grades 6 through 12
11 living within one and one half miles of the school in which ~~such~~the
12 pupil is enrolled."

13 Sec. 2. G.S. 115C-246(b) reads as rewritten:

14 "(b) Unless road or other conditions shall make it inadvisable to do so, public
15 school buses shall be so routed on State-maintained highways that the school ~~bus,~~to bus
16 to which ~~such a~~ pupil is assigned, ~~shall~~assigned shall pass within one mile of the
17 residence of each pupil, ~~pupil in grades 6 through 12 who lives one and one half miles or~~
18 more from the school to which ~~such the~~ pupil is assigned, ~~assigned and within one mile~~
19 of the residence of each pupil in grades kindergarten through 5."

20 Sec. 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
