AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ESTABLISH THREE SOIL SPECIALIST POSITIONS IN THE DIVISION OF SOIL AND WATER CONSERVATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT, HEALTH, AND NATURAL RESOURCES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources, Division of Soil and Water Conservation, the sum of one hundred thousand three hundred fifty-four dollars (\$100,354) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of one hundred thousand three hundred fifty-four dollars (\$100,354) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to establish, support, and provide travel expenses for three soil specialist positions in the Soil Survey Section. These three positions shall replace three federally funded soil specialist positions that are due to expire June 30, 1993, and that presently work with counties to conduct soil surveys throughout the State and map soil locations and identities.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
