1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO REVISE THE SALARY SCHEDULES FOR NONCERTIFIED PUBLIC
3 SCHOOL PERSONNEL WHO ARE CLASSIFIED AS OFFICE SUPPORT
4 PERSONNEL.

5 Whereas, the overwhelming majority of office support personnel employed
6 by public schools are receiving salaries significantly below \$1,270 per month; and

7 Whereas, revisions have been made to the salary schedules that have resulted
8 in disparity in the salary schedules of noncertified personnel; and

9 Whereas, the average salary of office support personnel is well below the
10 State allotment for office support personnel; Now, therefore,

11 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

12 Section 1. (a) Effective July 1, 1993, the following salary schedules shall be
13 applicable to noncertified public school personnel who are in the five classifications as
14 office support personnel:

27 (b) Office support personnel shall be placed on the new salary schedules on the
28 basis of years of experience as an office support person.

29 (c) An office support person who holds a current PSP (Professional Standards
30 Program) certificate shall receive an additional one percent (1%) of base salary.

31 (d) Longevity payments are not included in the revised salary schedules for
32 office support personnel.

33 (e) The State Board of Education shall adopt rules necessary to implement
34 the revised salary schedules for office support personnel.

35 (f) The salary schedules established by this section and the rules adopted to
36 implement it shall apply to office support personnel paid with local funds.

37 Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of
38 Public Education the sum of ten million dollars (\$10,000,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal
39 year and the sum of ten million dollars (\$10,000,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to
40 implement the provisions of this act.

41 Sec. 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
