AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR TROUBLED YOUTH SERVED BY MOUNTAIN YOUTH RESOURCES.

11 12 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Mountain Youth Resources, Inc., of Cullowhee the sum of seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year for capital costs in providing a shelter for youth under 18 years of age from Macon, Jackson, Swain, Graham, Cherokee, Clay, and Haywood Counties who are runaways, homeless, or living in an unstable or critical situation where they are abused, neglected, undisciplined, or delinquent.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
