HOUSE BILL 1535

AN ACT TO EXEMPT CURRITUCK COUNTY AND THE WHALEHEAD
PRESERVATION TRUST AND CURRITUCK WILDLIFE MUSEUM, INC.,
FROM CERTAIN STATUTORY REQUIREMENTS IN THE RENOVATION OF
THE HISTORIC WHALEHEAD CLUB.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the County of Currituck and the Whalehead Preservation Trust and Currituck Wildlife Museum, Inc., may contract for the following design, renovation, and construction project without being subject to the requirements of G.S. 143-128, 143-129, 143-131, 143-132, 143-64.31, and 143-64.32:

- (1) The design and renovation of the historic Whalehead Club, located in Corolla, North Carolina, including renovation of the boathouse and adjacent boat basin area.

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification and expires upon completion of the project or January 1, 2004, whichever comes first.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 5th day of July, 1994.
