(5)	\$1,396,100 for the mattress, athletic equipment, and reupholstering facility at Lumberton;
(6)	\$321,780 for expansion of the janitorial products plant at Harnett;
(7)	\$316,560 for expansion of the cannery plant at Caledonia;
(8)	\$318,820 for a modular workstation at Marion;
(9)	\$264,780 for the reupholstery plant at Johnston;
(10)	\$495,800 for the custom cabinet shop at Marion; and
(11)	\$257,740 for the dairy and processing operation at Caledonia.
