A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE NORTH CAROLINA CAMP PROGRAM.

Whereas, the North Carolina 4-H educational centers (camps) are owned by the State, or deeded to an entity of the State, North Carolina State University; and

Whereas, no appropriated funds presently are allocated for the maintenance of these facilities; and

Whereas, each year, these facilities provide educational and recreational services to more than 10,000 North Carolina families representative of the State's population; and

Whereas, these properties represent capital assets of more than \$7,000,000 contributed by citizen volunteers; and

Whereas, the North Carolina Youth Development Department at North Carolina State University needs funds to meet mandated safety, health and fire compliance, and accessibility improvements to meet needs of the youth of North Carolina; Now, therefore,

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of two million dollars (\$2,000,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to be used by North Carolina State University for expenses relating to the mandated safety, health, and fire compliance and accessibility requirements of its 4-H camp programs.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
