A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE EDUCATIONAL CONSORTIUM
AT THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA AT CHAPEL HILL.

Whereas, the 1993 General Assembly appropriated \$150,000 for the 1993-94 fiscal year only for the work of an educational consortium at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill; and

Whereas, the General Assembly appropriated similar amounts for seven other campus-based educational consortia on a continuing basis; and

Whereas, the Educational Consortium at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill has demonstrated its effectiveness during the current fiscal year in organizational and developmental activities designed to improve the public schools;

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of the University of North Carolina the sum of one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year, for the operation of the Educational Consortium at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill.

This item shall become part of the continuation budget of the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
