A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR FULL IMPLEMENTATION OF THE BASIC EDUCATION PROGRAM.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to State Aid to Local School Administrative Units the sum of three hundred fifteen million three hundred fifty-four thousand seven hundred forty-one dollars (\$315,354,741) for the 1994-95 fiscal year for full implementation of the Basic Education Program. These funds shall be allocated as follows:

(2)	Teachers to reduce class size in grades 9-12	24,192,630
(3)	Assistant Principals	16,151,271
(4)	Athletic Trainer Supplement	7,000
