A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF CRIME
2 CONTROL AND PUBLIC SAFETY TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL RESOURCES
3 TO THE CRIME PREVENTION DIVISION.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of
7 Crime Control and Public Safety the sum of seventy-nine thousand three hundred fifty-
8 seven dollars (\$79,357) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to provide additional resources to the
9 Crime Prevention Division so that the Division may more effectively respond to
10 demands for support in the areas of juvenile, violent, public housing, and inner-city
11 community crime prevention.

12 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
