A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN
3 RESOURCES, DIVISION OF AGING, TO DEVELOP A PROGRAM WHICH
4 UTILIZES OLDER ADULT VOLUNTEERS IN AFTER-SCHOOL PROGRAMS
5 FOR AT-RISK MIDDLE SCHOOL STUDENTS.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of
8 Human Resources, Division of Aging, the sum of two million five hundred twenty
9 thousand dollars (\$2,520,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to develop a program which
10 utilizes older adult volunteers in comprehensive after-school programs that target at-risk
11 middle school students. These funds shall be used to cover training, stipends, and other
12 support costs for the volunteers in one-half of the middle schools and junior high
13 schools in the State. This program shall be administered by the Department of Human
14 Resources, Division of Aging, and should be compatible with federal guidelines for the
15 Foster Grandparent Program.

16 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
