AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A SPECIAL RESERVE FUND TO COVER THE POTENTIAL LIABILITY OF THE STATE IN THE **SWANSON V. STATE** LAWSUIT AND TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE RESERVE FUND.

Section 1. There is established in the Department of Revenue a special nonreverting fund to be known as the "Swanson v. State Fund." The funds shall be held in reserve to be used to pay any back taxes the State may have to pay in the Swanson v. State lawsuit if the State does not prevail. The Swanson v. State Fund shall terminate, and all funds remaining in the Fund shall revert to the General Fund, if the State prevails in that lawsuit.

Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Swanson v. State Fund for the 1994-95 fiscal year the sum of fifty million dollars (\$50,000,000) to implement this act.
