A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT RENTAL BOOTHS ARE NOT COSMETIC ART SHOPS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 88-4 reads as rewritten:

"§ 88-4. Beauty parlor, etc.

'Cosmetic art shop,' 'beauty parlor,' or 'hairdressing establishment' is any building, or part thereof wherein cosmetic art is ~~practiced,~~ practiced; provided that an individual rental booth is not a cosmetic art shop. ~~and a~~ 'beauty school,' 'beauty college,' or 'beauty academy' is any building or part thereof wherein cosmetic art is taught."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
