A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO AMEND THE MONETARY LIMITS FOR PURPOSES OF  
2 COMPLYING WITH FORMAL BIDDING REQUIREMENTS BY THE CITY OF  
3 GREENSBORO.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. The first sentence of G.S. 143-129 is amended to read:

7 "No construction or repair work requiring the estimated expenditure of public money  
8 in an amount equal to three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) for street construction  
9 or repair and appurtenances connected therewith, or in an amount equal to or more than  
10 one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for other construction or repair work, or  
11 purchase of apparatus, supplies, materials, or equipment requiring an estimated  
12 expenditure of public money in an amount equal to or more than thirty thousand dollars  
13 (\$30,000), except in cases of group purchases made by hospitals through a competitive  
14 bidding purchasing program or in cases of special emergency involving the health and  
15 safety of the people or their property, shall be performed, nor shall any contract be  
16 awarded therefor, by any board or governing body of the State, or of any institution of  
17 State government, or of any county, city, town or other subdivision of the State, unless  
18 the provisions of this section are complied with."

19 Sec. 2. Sections 1 and 2 of Chapter 53, Session Laws of 1987, are repealed.

20 Sec. 3. This act applies to the city of Greensboro only.

21 Sec. 4. This act is effective upon ratification.
