A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO IMPLEMENT A RECOMMENDATION OF THE CHILD FATALITY
2 TASK FORCE TO REQUIRE THE DIVISION OF SOCIAL SERVICES
3 CONVENE A COMMITTEE TO DEVELOP A CHILD MEDICAL AND
4 MENTAL HEALTH EVALUATION PLAN.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 Section 1. (a) The Secretary of Human Resources shall convene an ad hoc
8 committee within the Division of Social Services, Department of Human Resources, to
9 develop a collaborative plan to provide medical and mental health evaluations to all
10 children suspected of being abused or neglected, regardless of whether they are referred
11 for evaluations by child protective services programs. The plan shall include how best
12 to use existing resources and shall also include a recommendation for the amount of
13 new funding needed, if existing resources do not cover all children.

14 (b) The committee shall consist of representatives of:

- 15 (1) The Child Medical Evaluation Program;
- 16 (2) The Division of Medical Assistance;
- 17 (3) The Victim's Assistance Program;
- 18 (4) The Division of Maternal and Child Health;
- 19 (5) The Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities, and
20 Substance Abuse Services;
- 21 (6) The Office of Rural Health;
- 22 (7) The Department of Insurance; and
- 23 (8) Any other appropriate public or private agencies.

1 The Secretary may also request any appropriate individual to be a member of the
2 committee.

3 (c) The committee shall report the plan it develops, together with any
4 legislative proposals, to the General Assembly and the Child Fatality Task Force by
5 March 15, 1994.

6 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
