A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COMMISSION TO
2 STUDY REDUCING THE LEGAL LIMIT OF BLOOD ALCOHOL FROM 0.10
3 TO 0.02 FOR PERSONS EIGHTEEN TO TWENTY YEARS OF AGE.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. The Legislative Research Commission may study issues
7 concerning the reduction of the legal limit of blood alcohol from 0.10 to 0.02 for 18 to
8 20 year olds while driving a motor vehicle and other relevant changes to the law
9 concerning impaired driving.

10 Sec. 2. The Legislative Research Commission may make an interim report to
11 the 1993 General Assembly, 1994 Regular Session, and shall make a final report to the
12 1995 General Assembly.

13 Sec. 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Legislative
14 Research Commission the sum of fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) for the 1993-94
15 fiscal year and the sum of fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year
16 to fund the Legislative Research Commission study authorized by this act.

17 Sec. 4. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
