A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COMMISSION TO
STUDY WAYS TO IMPROVE GUARDIANSHIP SERVICES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The Legislative Research Commission may study ways and means of improving the provision of guardianship services including increased quality of services, the avoidance of conflicts of interest, the role of State agencies, the coordination of services statewide, and the adequacy of staffing and funding.

Sec. 2. The Legislative Research Commission may make an interim report to the 1993 General Assembly, 1994 Regular Session, and shall make a final report to the 1995 General Assembly.

Sec. 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Legislative Research Commission the sum of fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to fund the Legislative Research Commission study authorized by this act.

Sec. 4. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
