1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING FOR THE AID TO 3 PUBLIC LIBRARIES FUND. 4 Whereas, North Carolina's public libraries provide valuable services to all the 5 people of the State; and Whereas, it is the stated purpose of the General Assembly to provide an Aid 6 7 to Public Libraries Fund; and Whereas, it is the purpose of the Aid to Public Libraries Fund established in 8 9 G.S. 125-7 to improve, stimulate, increase, and equalize public library service to the people of the whole State; and 10 Whereas, the Aid to Public Libraries Fund has made a positive impact in 11 12

providing quality public library services; Now, therefore,

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Cultural Resources the sum of eleven million five hundred thousand dollars (\$11,500,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year and the sum of eleven million five hundred thousand dollars (\$11,500,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to be allocated to the Aid to Public Libraries Fund.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
